Description of the work package					

Description of the work package

The methodology has been defined in order to mainstream the green taxation best practices of the selected deliverable into the fiscal policies of new MED municipalities with the final purpose of promoting RES. The approach is based on the involvement of new associations of municipalities as receivers partners. The givers partners (MUSOL and FVMP) will develop the technical skills of such receivers partners. It will enable the associations of municipalities to advise new municipalities regarding green local taxation once the project is ended and it permits to mainstream the capitalized green local fiscal policies into a higher number of local authorities' policies. The givers partners and associated partners will train the receivers partners as well as the receivers municipalities about the fiscal policies described in the selected deliverable and the methodology to adapt such policy models to the specific features of the receivers municipalities. In the receivers municipalities, each partner will identify the main stakeholders according to the participatory method already tested in the LOCAL4GREEN project and will create a working group (WG) formed by policy makers, technical decision makers, affected taxpayers representatives, etc. Such a group will facilitate all the information needed to analyse and adapt the fiscal policy models. The receivers partners, supported by the givers partners, will elaborate a customized viability study in each pilot municipality to define in detail the tailored fiscal policies to be mainstreamed. Such study will be discussed in the WG. Once agreed the policy, the relevant policy act will be elaborated in each receiver municipality. At the same time, the receiver partners will deploy an intensive process of liaising to convince the competent services and the policy makers to get the policy approved. Furthermore, technical advice will be provided for the adopting procedures and during the implementation of the approved fiscal policy.

#### Justification

The deliverable to be capitalized is the "International Handbook on Green Local Fiscal Policy" produced by the project LOCAL4GREEN. The main content of the handbook is the description of the local fiscal policies designed and tested in several pilot local authorities to promote the renewable energy sources. The results of the LOCAL4GREEN pilots permitted to define the policy models of green local fiscal policies described in the handbook. Secondarily, the handbook includes policy recommendations for the regional and national authorities in order to improve the autonomy of the local authorities to promote the local green taxation and extend the green taxation at other subnational levels (mainly the regional level). Since the specific content of the selected deliverable are a set of local policies, the capitalization of the deliverable intrinsically means the incorporation of such policies models into the local policies of new municipalities. The project therefore selected the WP Mainstreaming that precisely aims at integrating the selected deliverable into the local policy framework. As mentioned above, the approach is based on the involvement of new associations of municipalities as receivers partners and the engagement of new local authorities as receivers associated partners. Such receivers associations of municipalities will include the green fiscal policy models proposed by the selected deliverable in their policies and support services for their municipalities members. Furthermore, they will concretely incorporate such green local fiscal policies into the policies of the local authorities receivers associated partners.

			At the beginning of the project, a detailed training session will be provided by MUSOL and the FVMP to the "receivers" partners in order to develop the skills needed to mainstream into new municipalities the green local fiscal policies described in the LOCAL4GREEN deliverable "International Handbook on Green Local Fiscal Policy". Such training will be organized together with the kick off meeting and it can be online or face-to-face, depending on the evolution of the pandemic.  The receivers associated partners municipalities will be later trained through national courses organized by each partner (1 per partner). Such training is key to develop the technical and legal skills to mainstream the green local fiscal policies. The "givers" associated partners (former LOCAL4GREEN partners and pilot municipalities) will also collaborate as speakers to ensure the transfer on a horizontal basis of the technical and legal details of the green local fiscal policy models.  The training will be open also to the municipalities of the "regional groups" and "flagship cases" supported by the Interreg MED Renewable energy community (horizontal project - HP) in the process of implementation of the Ecosystemic Transition Units (ETUs). Such regional groups are being created by the horizontal project in Italy, Spain, Greece, Slovenia and Croatia. Furthermore, since the HP has planned specific training sessions for their regional groups municipalities, the project's partners will provide trainers for the HP courses with knowledge of the green local fiscal policy models and will be proficient in English, Greek, Italian and Spanish. As agreed with the HP in the phase of preparation, the Croatian partner that was a LOCAL4GREEN partner and has all the competences to properly carry out the training. 	Description		The receivers partners staff and external experts (supported on site or remotely by the givers partners and associated partners) will analyze the municipality's GHG inventory, the budget and specific municipal taxes and fees income and other relevant data to define the fiscal policies with a higher impact in terms of renewable energy promotion as well as to identify the green fiscal policies more consistent with the municipality's budget constraints (among the policies described in the selected deliverable).  Furthermore, the EU transversal principles will be taken into account as described in the chapter "C.3 EU principles". Specially the social inclusion aspects have increasing relevance due to the COVID19 economic crisis.  Furthermore, such analysis will permit to define the specific scope, the magnitude (% of fiscal benefits, etc.) and other details of the capitalized fiscal policies that need to be tailored according to the specific features of each municipality. Such adaptation process will produce customized viability studies. The viability studies will be discussed in the WGs that will decide the adapted green local fiscal policies that will be concretely mainstreamed in each municipality.  Each partner will implement the activity in the municipalities involved as receiver associated partners of its territory of competence (in the case of Spain, MUSOL will implement the activity in the Spanish municipalities). The interested municipalities of the HP regional groups will be also supported. Since the capitalized LOCAL4GREEN deliverable includes also policy recommendations for the regional authorities and provided that the Valencian community regional government (Spain) expressed interested (it is an associated partner), MUSOL and the FVMP will draft concrete mainstreaming tailored studies for the Valencian regional policies. De	Description		Once the WGs have discussed the customized viability studies and have defined which green fiscal policies to mainstream, the receivers partners staff and external experts (supported by the givers partners and associated partners) will elaborate in collaboration with the local authority's staff the acts (municipal ordinances or other) that have to be adopted by the proper municipal bodies (municipal council, mayor or other) to implement the green fiscal policies. At least one fiscal policy listed in the LOCAL4GREEN capitalized deliverable will be adapted in each municipalities of the regional groups/ ETU flagship supported by the Interreg MED Renewable energy community. The formal commitment of adoption of the policy acts can be the formal approval of the policy acts, the inclusion of the policy in the new/updated SECAP/SEAP in the framework of the Covenant of Mayors or other formal commitment of implementation of the mainstreamed policy issued by the municipality.  Each partner will implement the activity in the municipalities involved as receiver associated partners of its territory of competence (in the case of Spain, MUSOL will implement the activity in the Spanish municipalities). In addition, the interested municipalities of the RE community regional groups will be also supported to draft the policy acts, in coordination with the horizontal project.  It is worth to mention that the FVMP and MUSOL will not only support the receiver partners in the whole process of mainstreaming and strategic liaising. Description	Once the policy acts are ready, the receivers partners staff and external experts (supported by the givers partners and associated partners) will deploy an intensive process to ensure the commitment of the local authorities' competent services and policy makers to approve the capitalized green fiscal policies. Furthermore, the project will provide support on the voting and adopting procedures as well as guidance to the public technical services for the implementation of the policies once adopted. Local authorities' policy makers and technical decision makers (legal advisors, chief executives of key areas such as budget and fiscal departments, etc.) will be specifically addressed to ensure the concrete adoption of the capitalized policies. Such strategic liaising process will be carried out through interviews, meetings, horizontal exchanges with former LOCAL4GREEN pilots municipalities that have approved green local fiscal policies, etc. Such tasks may be online or face-to-face, depending on the evolution of the pandemic.  This activity is crucial to ensure the concrete integration of the capitalized fiscal policies into the local policies to promote the RES. The actual mainstreaming can be formalized through policy acts, inclusion of the green local fiscal policies in SECAP/updated SECAPs of the Covenant of Mayors, or other formal commitments. Each partner will implement the activity in the municipalities involved as receiver associated partners of its territory of competence. In addition, the interested municipalities of the RE community regional groups will be also supported, in coordination with the horizontal project. MUSOL and the FVMP will provide technical and institutional support to the Spanish receivers municipalities as well as advisory in all the activity to the receivers municipalities as well as advisory in all the activity to the receivers partners.
